

BHAS ANNUAL OUTING - SATURDAY 3d JULY 2010

OLD SARUM, SALISBURY CATHEDRAL AND MUSEUM

We will be leaving Brighton early in the morning and driving straight to Old Sarum (a couple of miles north of Salisbury) where we start by having a guided tour of the site and later have free time to explore. This site began life as an Iron Age Hillfort, has Roman remains and later a Norman Castle Mott. In the afternoon we will drive into Salisbury, for a guided tour of the Cathedral, followed by a visit to the Salisbury Museum in the Cathedral precincts. Both the Museum and Cathedral have cafes, so there will be no shortage of refreshments in the afternoon, although it might be advisable to bring a picnic for earlier in the day. Old Sarum only has a tea and coffee machine, and cold drinks available for visitors.

There are two prices for this trip — all depending in whether you are a member of English Heritage, and membership cards will be necessary at the time of entry to Old Sarum. The overall price includes coach travel, two guided tours and entry to Old Sarum, Salisbury Cathedral and Museum.
